## Which policies do schools have to have?

#### **Local Authority Maintained Schools:**

- All local authority (LA)-maintained schools, including maintained special schools
- Maintained and non-maintained nursery schools
- Pupil referral units (PRUs)
- Non-maintained special schools, because your requirements are more similar to maintained schools than to academies or independent schools

This is a long list: many or not particularly relevant to parents/carers.
