- The morning - offer a welcome to every child
- Notice - name and identify thoughts
- Listen - so ask questions about thoughts
- Create a (shared) past - to reminisce about
- Laugh - share a joke
- Remember - a birthday or event
- Admire - out loud to others
- Praise in writing
- Respect - family, history, culture
- Share - football team, pop star, sweets
- Steal crisps
- Promote - tell good stories to others, staff/kids/families
- Acknowledge something they are better at than you
- Recognise - around the school, beyond the school, cheerfully
- 'I saw this and I thought of you' - give them a cutting from a newspaper or magazine, about their team, etc.
- Collect
- Contribute to the 'X factor'
- Mark (notice / remember) - privately, journals of progress, intimate conversations
- Find the invisible child
- Confess - to private interests - sharing something of yourself

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
