Supporting the pupil who has experienced significant relational traumas and losses.

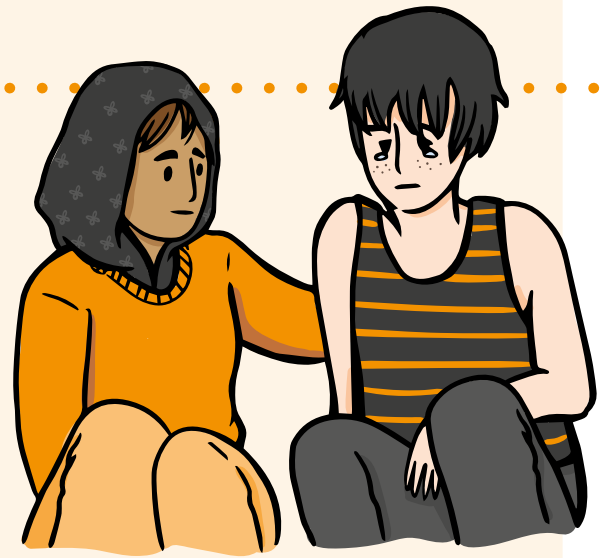
